

The Eastern Bay Oyster Siting Survey

The Eastern Bay and its tributaries provide commercial and recreational opportunities to many. These waters are also populated by countless wild species, including many economically important fisheries. Many people call this area their home or have other reasons to feel connected to the area. Efforts to restore and support wild oyster populations and oyster aquaculture will help ensure the bounty provided by these waterways and the health of wild populations into the future.
